Coos County Concealed Handgun License Informational Guide

This guide will provide general information that a Concealed Handgun Licensee **must** be aware of in regards to the restrictions of this license. You are undertaking a great responsibility by receiving a permit to carry a concealed weapon for lawful self-defense. A permit to carry concealed **IS NOT** a permit to attack. If you do find it necessary to use your weapon, the law will protect you **ONLY IF YOU HAVE ACTED WITHIN THE LAW.**

You **MUST carry on your person your valid, current Concealed Handgun License with your current address whenever you carry a concealed handgun. Failure to do so could result in a charge of Unlawful Possession of a Firearm, a Class A Misdemeanor, and/or your license being SEIZED and REVOKED.**

IF YOU MOVE

You **must** change your address within **30 days**. If you move to a new address in Coos County you will need to apply for a change of address. If you have moved to another county in Oregon, contact the Sheriff's Office of that county for hours and procedures to transfer your CHL permit to that county.

If you have not notified the DMV of your address change, please do so first, as we will not be able to process your request if your ODL and CHL addresses do not match. Failure to have a permit with your current address can result in the revocation of your Concealed Handgun License.

A Concealed Handgun License **DOES NOT AUTHORIZE** you to carry a concealed firearm on any of the following properties:

- Any Courtroom, Jury Room, Judge's Chambers, or areas adjacent thereto that the presiding judge determines should be free of firearms to ensure the safety of the litigants, court personnel, witnesses and others.
- City Hall – Municipal Courts
- County Courthouses & County Buildings
- Any State Agency or building as a State Agency or Municipal Corporation
- Any Federal Facility or Federal Courthouses including Post Offices, Social Security Administration Buildings, Recruiting Offices (18 USC 930) and Veteran's Administration Services
- Airports or Airplanes (Contact TSA for current Regulations)
- Indian Reservations or Indian Property without the written permission of the tribal judge. (*This applies to Indian Casinos that are on Indian Lands.*)
- Many private businesses have conditions regarding the possession of firearms on their premises. If you violate these conditions you could, under certain circumstances, be subject to arrest under Oregon trespass laws, in which case your concealed handgun license would be seized and/or revoked.

POSSESSING a LOADED or UNLOADED WEAPON IN THESE AREAS COULD RESULT in an ARREST.



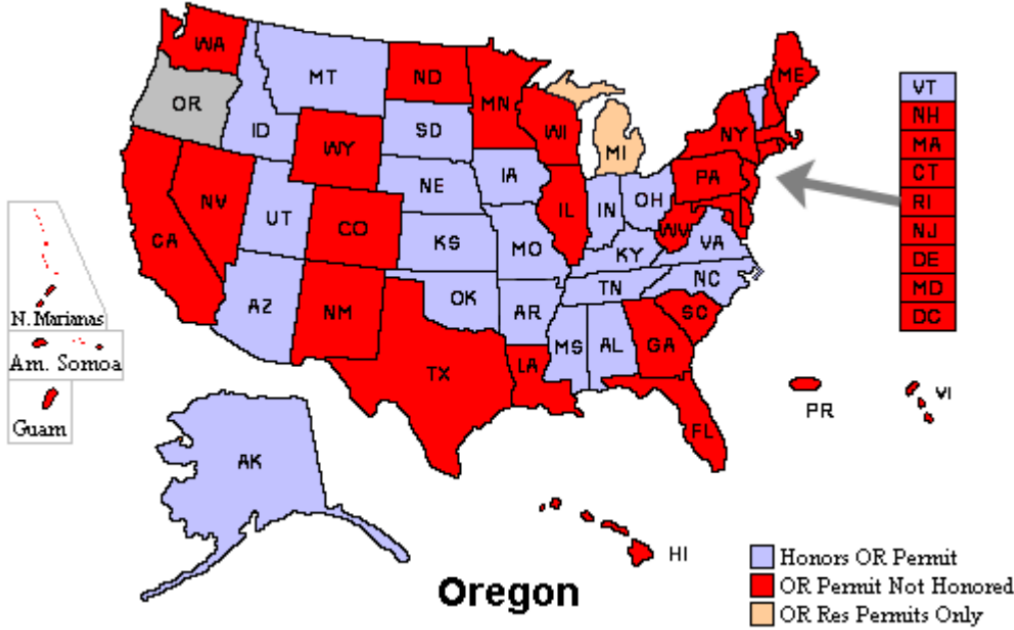

Note: When traveling to other states that do honor an Oregon Concealed Handgun License, you may be required to advise law enforcement immediately during a traffic stop if you are carrying a concealed weapon and that you possess a valid concealed handgun license from the State of Oregon. * Reciprocity and recognition between states is subject to frequent change through legislative action and regulatory interpretation. You should always contact the state you are traveling to for the most accurate and updated information regarding carrying a handgun in that area before leaving Oregon.

Note: 09-28-2011 Oregon Court of Appeals ruled that a valid CHL holder can carry concealed on college campuses, refer to www.publications.ojd.state.or.us/A142974.pdf.

Federal Law 18 U.S. Code 926A - Interstate Transportation of Firearms: any person who is not otherwise prohibited by this chapter from transporting, shipping, or receiving a firearm shall be entitled to transport a firearm for any lawful purpose from any place where he may lawfully possess and carry such firearm to any other place where he may lawfully possess and carry such firearm if, during such transportation the firearm is unloaded, and neither the firearm nor any ammunition being transported is readily accessible or is directly accessible from the passenger compartment of such transporting vehicle. That in the case of a vehicle without a compartment separate from the driver's compartment the firearm or ammunition shall be contained in a locked container other than the glove compartment or console.

National Parks and National Wildlife Refuges. That means if you have a permit/license that is legal in the state the National Park is located in you can carry in that National Park. *Title 36 Chpt. 1 Part 2 § 2.4 (This does not prohibit the carrying of firearms on federal lands, other than designated wilderness areas, incident to hunting or other lawful purposes.)* [OAR 629-025-0050]

[You cannot carry into a Ranger Station or Visitor's Info Center Buildings (or restroom) as these are considered federal buildings.]
