Bonds to Improve Schools and Classrooms, Address Safety, Repairs, Security

Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall Coos Bay School District issue \$66,475,000 in bonds to construct new schools and update others for safety and security? If the bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

If approved, the bond proceeds are expected to fund:

- Demolition of Harding Building (except gym) and replacement with new 7th-8th Grade Building and additional Fitness/Multi-Purpose Gym;
- Demolition of Eastside Elementary and construction of new Elementary School in its place to replace Blossom Gulch Elementary;
- Additions to Madison Elementary to replace temporary classrooms and restrooms and increase instructional space;
- Renovations to Madison, Sunset and Millicoma Schools to improve safety, security, accessibility, efficiency and building systems;
- Related capital costs including Building Needs Assessments;
- Site improvements, demolition, furnishing and equipping of projects and bond issuance costs.

Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed 26 years from issuance. The estimated tax rate is approximately \$1.85 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. Actual rates may differ based upon interest rates incurred and growth in assessed value.
